- Vln. I**: Violin I, rests until measure 13, then *pizz.* marked *mf*, then *arco* marked *p*.
- Vln. II**: Violin II, rests until measure 13, then *unis.* marked *mp*, then *div.* marked *p*.
- Vla.**: Viola, rests until measure 13, then *mp*, then *div.* marked *p*.
- Vc.**: Violoncello, rests until measure 13, then *gliss.* marked *mp*, then *sul II* marked *mf*, then *p* and *arco* marked *p*.
- Cb.**: Contrabass, rests throughout.

Measure numbers 12 through 21 are indicated at the bottom of the page.
